would like to share with you the real life story of engineer John Roebling. Since I too am an

engineer, I was inspired by the facts. In 1883, John Roebling, a creative engineer, was inspired to build the Brooklyn Bridge connecting New York with Long Island.

However, bridge experts throughout the world told him that this was an impossible task. John couldn't ignore the vision, so he persuaded his son Washington to work alongside him. Working together for the first time, the father and son developed concepts of how it could be accomplished and how the obstacles could be overcome.

A few months later, John died of a tragic accident. Later on, Washington too was injured and left with brain damage which resulted in him being paralyzed. In spite of his handicap, Washington was never discouraged. As he lay on his bed, he came up with an idea to communicate with his wife. With only a tap on her arm he devised a method to give instructions to the engineers to start work on the bridge.

For 13 years Washington tapped out his instructions, until the bridge was finally completed in 1883. Today, the spectacular Brooklyn Bridge stands in all its glory as a tribute to the triumph of one man's indomitable spirit and determination not to be defeated by circumstances.

Perhaps this is one great example of a never-say-die attitude. Often when we face obstacles in our day-to-day life, our hurdles seem very small in comparison to what others have faced. This story could remind us that dreams that seem impossible can be realized with determination and persistence no matter what the odds.


