nternational Women's Day is set aside as a celebration of those ordinary women whose courageous and determined acts served to play a historical role. I would like to share one such story of a hero.

Muniba Mazari, a young lady with a degree in Fine Arts, has been wheelchair bound since 2007 due to a tragic road accident. The accident changed her life for good. She is known as the Iron Lady of Pakistan. She decided to find her inner strength by using art as a tool.

She is an amazing painter, a motivational speaker, social activist, TV anchor, a model and an amazing singer. In every field she has taught us that, in spite of being disabled, anything we set our mind to can be achieved with the right spirit. She is Asia's first wheelchair bound television host who works as an anchor for Pakistan national TV. She was one of BBC's 100 most influential women in the world in 2015. She is one of Pond's miracle mentors. She has been recently nominated as the very first Goodwill Ambassador for UN Women in Pakistan.

Through her work and life story, Mazari aspires to inspire those who have lost hope. The only message she gives to the world is that 'You are the hero of your own life story and Heroes Never Give Up!'

She is a role model and a source of inspiration for all of us. She has taught us that limitations are just an illusion in our minds and nothing in this world can stop you from achieving your goals.


