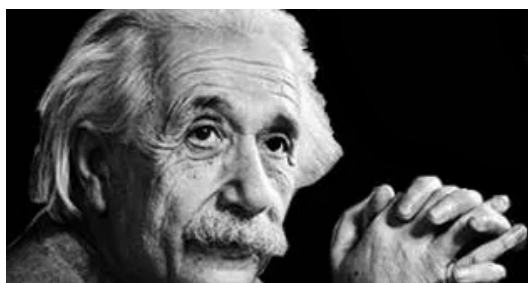


PRECAUTION AGAINST SPREADING DISEASES
