DEAR PARENTS,

She has over 10 years of experience and currently attached to the Asiri hospitals as a visiting consultant.

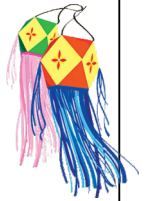

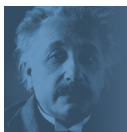
